In Freital-Potschappel, just outside of the royal city of Dresden, decorative porcelain has been being produced since 1872. Porcelain from Dresden is regarded traditionally as a synonym for luxury due to its valuable combination of ornaments, borders, edges, ribbons, flowers and bouquets. Vintage patterns are still being used to design and paint the traditional pieces of art in almost infinite variety. This can only be done by hand. And exactly this handwork is guaranteed by their trademark – the entwined initials “S” and “P” in the monogram of the Sächsische Porzellan Manufaktur Dresden.
